

Appendix E: Trends Among Other Institutions of Higher Education and Industries

- Currently there are at least 774 colleges or universities which have 100% indoor and outdoor smoke-free policies with no exemptions. Residential housing facilities are included, where they exist. Of these, 562 campuses have a 100% tobacco-free policy.
- In Missouri, 16 institutions have passed policies to be 100% smokefree indoors and out. Of these, 11 are 100% tobacco free polices. Three of these 16 campuses have passed policies and are in an incremental implementation phase.
- Regarding UCM's peer institutions: five institutions are 100% smokefree indoors and out. Of these, four are 100% tobacco free.
- The NCAA prohibits tobacco use in all forms during practice and competition by student-athletes and game personnel.
- Certain industries/locations in which UCM students may be employed show a trend of becoming smoke free¹³:
 - 3,240 local/state hospitals or health care systems and 4 national hospitals/insurers/health providers (Kaiser Permanente, Mayo Clinic, SSM Health Care, CIGNA Corp.)
 - 250 U.S. Airports
 - 17 NFL stadiums, 21 MLB stadiums
 - 23 states, along with Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Washington D.C, have a law in effect that requires non-hospitality workplaces, restaurants, and bars to be 100% smokefree.
 - 66 nations have enacted 100% smokefree laws with respect to non-hospitality workplaces, restaurants, bars, and casinos
